

## Bible Reading Memory Plan—NKJV – 2008

This plan is designed to be used in conjunction with the Bible Reading Plan. Every week a verse(s) is selected from assigned reading. The verses will appear each week in the bulletin and can be accessed on the church website. Small groups going through the Bible Reading Plan may also recite them weekly.

### Week of 1/1-1/6

**Genesis 3:15** <sup>15</sup> And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."

### Week of 1/7-13

**Matthew 5:17-18** <sup>17</sup> " Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. <sup>18</sup> "For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.

### Week of 1/14-20

**Acts 10:42-43** <sup>42</sup> "And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God *to be* Judge of the living and the dead. <sup>43</sup> "To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins."

### Week of 1/21-27

**Psalms 23:1-3** <sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalms 23:1** A Psalm of David. The LORD *is* my shepherd; I shall not want. <sup>2</sup> He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. <sup>3</sup> He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

### Week of 1/28-2/3

**Matthew 11:28-30** <sup>28</sup> "Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> "For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light."

### Week of 2/4-10

**Exodus 20:1-3** <sup>NKJ</sup> **Exodus 20:1** And God spoke all these words, saying: <sup>2</sup> " I *am* the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. <sup>3</sup> " You shall have no other gods before Me.

### Week of 2/11-17

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalms 34:8** Oh, taste and see that the LORD *is* good; Blessed *is* the man *who* trusts in Him!

### Week of 2/18-24

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Acts 28:23** So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at *his* lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening.

### Week of 2/24-3/2

**Romans 1:16-17** <sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."

### Week of 3/3-9

**Psalm 51:9-10** <sup>9</sup> Hide Your face from my sins, And blot out all my iniquities. <sup>10</sup> Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

**Week of 3/10-16**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Numbers 23:19** "God *is* not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?"

**Week of 3/17-23**

**Romans 11:33-36** <sup>33</sup> Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable *are* His judgments and His ways past finding out! <sup>34</sup> "For who has known the mind of the LORD? Or who has become His counselor?" <sup>35</sup> "Or who has first given to Him And it shall be repaid to him?" <sup>36</sup> For of Him and through Him and to Him *are* all things, to whom *be* glory forever. Amen.

**Week of 3/24-4/6**

**Matthew 28:18 - 20**<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." Amen.

**Week of 4/7-13**

**Joshua 24:14-15** <sup>14</sup> " Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD! <sup>15</sup> "And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

**Week of 4/14-20**

**Psalm 90:1-2** <sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalm 90:1** A Prayer of Moses the man of God. LORD, You have been our dwelling place in all generations. <sup>2</sup> Before the mountains were brought forth, Or ever You had formed the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, You *are* God.

**Week of 4/21-27**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Corinthians 15:3** For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

**Week of 4/28-5/4**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Mark 10:45** "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

**Week of 5/5-11**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **2 Corinthians 5:6** So *we are* always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. <sup>7</sup> For we walk by faith, not by sight. <sup>8</sup> We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.

**Week of 5/12-18**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalm 111:1** Praise the LORD! I will praise the LORD with *my* whole heart, In the assembly of the upright and *in* the congregation.<sup>2</sup> The works of the LORD *are* great, Studied by all who have pleasure in them.

**Week of 5/19-25**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **2 Samuel 22:29** "For You *are* my lamp, O LORD; The LORD shall enlighten my darkness.

**Week of 5/26-6/1**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Ephesians 1:3** Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,<sup>4</sup> just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

**Week of 6/2-8**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalm 119:11** Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You!

**Week of 6/9-15**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Kings 18:38** Then the fire of the LORD fell and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood and the stones and the dust, and it licked up the water that *was* in the trench.<sup>39</sup> Now when all the people saw *it*, they fell on their faces; and they said, "The LORD, He *is* God! The LORD, He *is* God!"

**Week of 6/16-22**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Luke 6:27** " But I say to you who hear: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you,<sup>28</sup> "bless those who curse you, and pray for those who spitefully use you.

**Week of 6/23-29**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Philippians 4:4** Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!<sup>5</sup> Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord *is* at hand.<sup>6</sup> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

**Week of 6/30-7/6**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Colossians 1:13** He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love,<sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

**Week of 7/7-13**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Chronicles 16:10** Glory in His holy name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the LORD!<sup>11</sup> Seek the LORD and His strength; Seek His face evermore!

**Week of 7/14-20**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalm 139:17** How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them!<sup>18</sup> *If* I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; When I awake, I am still with You.

**Week of 7/21-27**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Luke 12:15** And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses."

**Week of 7/28-8/3**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Timothy 1:5** Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, *from* a good conscience, and *from* sincere faith,

**Week of 8/4-10**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Proverbs 6:16** These six *things* the LORD hates, Yes, seven *are* an abomination to Him: <sup>17</sup> A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood, <sup>18</sup> A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil,

**Week of 8/11-17**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Nehemiah 8:10** Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for *this day is holy* to our LORD. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."

**Week of 8/18-24**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Titus 3:4** But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, <sup>5</sup> not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

**Week of 8/25-9/7**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Proverbs 31:30** Charm *is* deceitful and beauty *is* passing, But a woman *who* fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

**Week of 9/8-14**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Luke 22:26** "But not so *among* you; on the contrary, he who is greatest among you, let him be as the younger, and he who governs as he who serves.

**Week of 9/15-21**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Isaiah 40:1** "Comfort, yes, comfort My people!" Says your God. <sup>2</sup> "Speak comfort to Jerusalem, and cry out to her, That her warfare is ended, That her iniquity is pardoned; For she has received from the LORD's hand Double for all her sins."

**Week of 9/22-28**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Hebrews 12:28** Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. <sup>29</sup> For our God *is* a consuming fire.

**Week of 9/29-10/5**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **John 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God.

**Week of 10/6-12**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Jeremiah 17:7** "Blessed *is* the man who trusts in the LORD, And whose hope is the LORD. <sup>8</sup> For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river, And will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, And will not be anxious in the year of drought, Nor will cease from yielding fruit.

**Week of 10/13-19**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Ecclesiastes 12:13** Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all.

**Week of 10/20-26**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 Peter 4:11** If anyone speaks, *let him speak* as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, *let him do it* as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. <sup>12</sup> Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you;

**Week of 10/27-11/2**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Job 2:10** But he said to her, "You speak as one of the foolish women speaks. Shall we indeed accept good from God, and shall we not accept adversity?" In all this Job did not sin with his lips.

**Week of 11/3-9**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **John 8:31** Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. <sup>32</sup> "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

**Week of 11/10-16**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Ezekiel 37:27** "My tabernacle also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people."

**Week of 11/17-23**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **1 John 5:14** Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. <sup>15</sup> And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

**Week of 11/24-30**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **John 13:34** "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. <sup>35</sup> "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

**Week of 12/1-7**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Hosea 3:5** Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the LORD their God and David their king. They shall fear the LORD and His goodness in the latter days.

**Week of 12/8-14**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Revelation 5:9** And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, <sup>10</sup> And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."

**Week of 12/15-21**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Job 42:2** "I know that You can do everything, And that no purpose *of Yours* can be withheld from You."

**Week of 12/22-28**

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Malachi 4:2** But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves."
